Sex Offender Registration Requirements

The Community Notification Act requires all sex offenders to register with the Sheriff of the county in which they wish to reside 30 days prior to moving into that residence. If the residence fails to meet the requirements of the Community Notification Act then the offender may not take up residence at that location. Also a sex offender may not change residence without permission from the Probation/Parole Officer and the Sheriff of the county in which they wish to reside. Sex Offenders may not travel or stay away from their residence for more than 5 consecutive days..

Sex Offender Special Conditions

Alabama does not place any special conditions not ordered by the court or paroling authorities, other than compliance with the Community Notification Act.
