USE OF COMMUNITY SERVICE AND CURFEW SANCTIONS

1. Community Service

a. Community service is a medium sanction that is applied in increments of four (4) hour blocks. Normal referral to CSSP is completed following sentencing, but, incremental performance of the community service is suspended until used by the officer to sanction a violation.

b. The following table lists the minimum number of hours recommended for the respective violation. The respective level of violation severity corresponds to the minimum number of community service hours:

Second violation	4 hours	8 hours	12 hours
Third violation	8 hours	12 hours	16 hours

c. The maximum community service hours performed within a six (6) month period should not exceed one hundred (100) hours.

2. Curfew

a. Curfew is a medium sanction that is applied incrementally from 1 to 21 days. Curfew is defined as confinement to one's house, quarters, domicile for a set period of time. The curfew time will be in effect from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. daily during the period of curfew. Exceptions to the curfew time can be made for employment, medical, or other emergency reasons.

b. The following table shows the recommended range of days for the respective violation during which a curfew shall be enforced. The recommendations coincide with the severity the violation and represents a choice of an exact number of curfew days:

	Low Severity	Medium Severity	High Severity
First violation	not applicable	1 - 2 days	3 - 7 days
Second violation	1 - 2 days	3 - 7 days	8 - 14 days
Third violation	3 - 7 days	8 - 14 days	15 - 21 days

c. Electronic monitoring devices are available for curfew periods exceeding 14 days.
