Sex Offender Registration Requirements

Kentucky requires all convicted sex offenders to register with the state police. Forcible crimes register for life. Consensual and other type crimes register for ten years as set forth by statute. All incoming offenders register for life.

Sex Offender Special Conditions

- May not live within 1000 feet of school or daycare.
- If supervised: May not live near a park, pool, or other place where children congregate.
- May not live in a home with minor children.
- May not have relationship without approval of officer.

Additional Information

Kentucky has a three year conditional discharge from prison whereby an offender serving out his sentence is supervised for three years after release to insure proper activities following incarceration.
